Many studies on the Chinese communities have concentrated on insular Southeast Asia and not much has been done on the Chinese in mainland Southeast Asia. This conference will focus on four mainland states, namely, Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia and Myanmar, with regard to their Chinese communities in a globalizing world. Issues which will be discussed include the changing policies of respective governments towards the Chinese minorities and the recent developments in Chinese business, culture and migration. China's investments (and those of Taiwan) in these countries will also be examined. Leading experts and scholars have been invited to participate in this one-day conference, which is jointly organized by The Institute of Southeast Asian Studies (ISEAS) and Chinese Heritage Centre (CHC). The aim is to provide up-to-date information on the situation of the ethnic Chinese in today's Indochinese states and Myanmar.
